The present power of attorney shall remain valid, irrespective of the entry in the commercial register, until it is revoked in writing. It shall remain valid upon the death of the authorised representative or of one or another shareholder in the company as well as in the event of any of the other reasons for expiry stated in Article 35 of the Swiss Code of Obligations.
